### The Macnamara Executive is Matching Your Trail Donations Until June 30

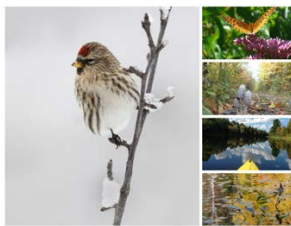


As club members know, we are fundraising to extend our beloved Macnamara Trail. We need approximately \$60,000 for this first phase and are close to this goal with over \$50,000 raised. **With your help, we can reach it.**

The first phase of our project begins this summer with the construction of the link to the north side of the property, which will connect the Macnamara Trail to a new 1.5-kilometre loop and offer access to Goodwin Marsh for wildlife observation. 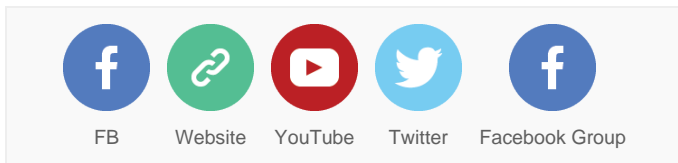
**When:** Tuesday, June 27, 2:30 p.m.- 4:30 p.m.
