As club members know, we are fundraising to extend our beloved Macnamara Trail. We need approximately \$60,000 for this first phase and are close to this goal with over \$50,000 raised. The first phase of our project begins this summer with the construction of the link to the north side of the property, which will connect the Macnamara Trail to a new 1.5-kilometre loop and offer access to Goodwin Marsh for wildlife observation.
